Initiative 1 – WOMP structure & content alignment

Comparative exercise performed, which highlighted the need for an aligned structure and content guide. Proposed WOMP templates based on ISO 16530 pending WOMP workshop.



Initiative 2 – Electronic WOMP (eWOMP)

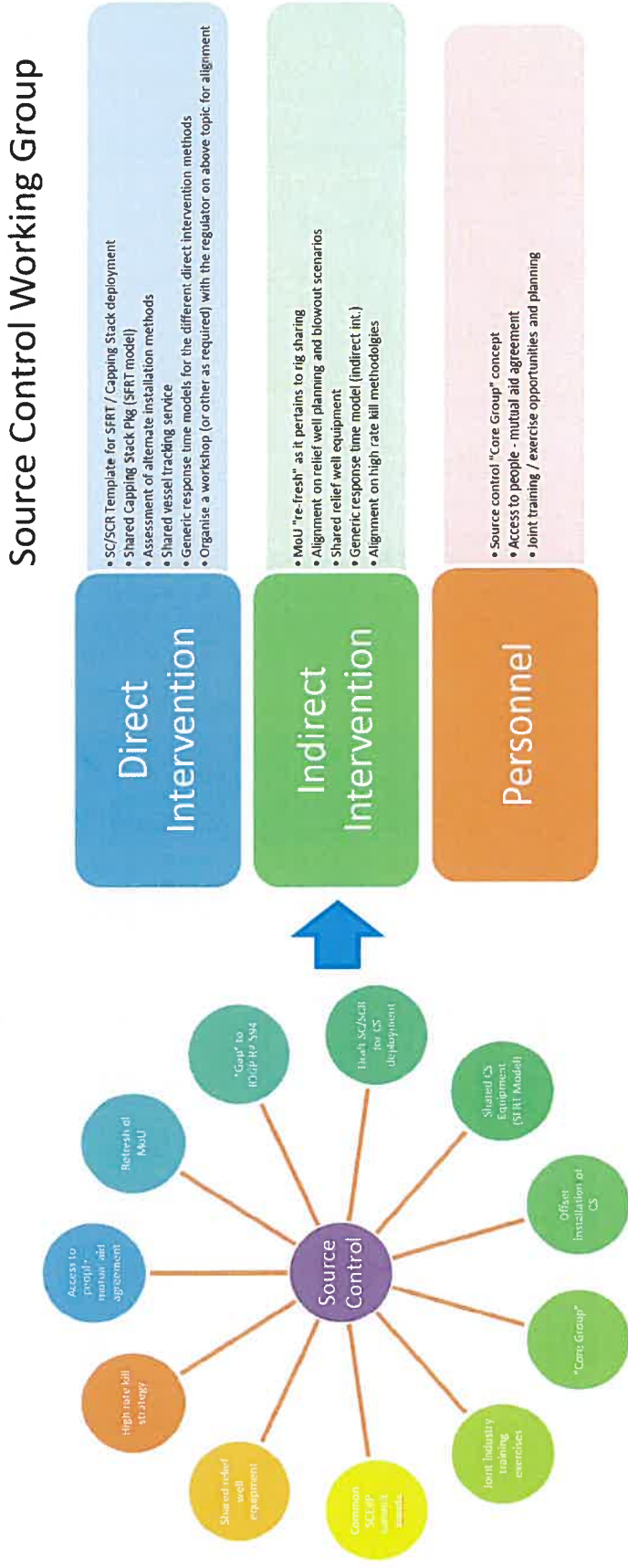
Potential digital solution investigated. Although promising, further investigations are on hold pending the WOMP workshop as the initial step.



Forward Plan

Jan 2021: DISC – NOPSEMA WOMP reform workshop

An open and frank forum to put all the collective issues on the table and identify reform measures to improve the WOMP administration process for all.



Purpose:

To collaborate and develop an Australian offshore industry source control plan to drive consistency between operators and to strengthen the industry's source control response preparedness.

- Sharing experience between Commonwealth and State water territory.
 - P&A technologies and sharing experience between operators
 - Developing a strategy with regards to seeking historical well abandonment approvals. Regulation of the day / regulation of today / geological practicalities
 - Monitoring and where practical engaging in emerging decommissioning legislation changes.
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D&C QA/QC Advisors meet every 6-8 weeks for an informal pen down meeting.

JOAP 2021 Audit Program

- Change of audit provider to Fearnley
 - Considering a range of audits beyond contractor management system e.g. API Q2 gap audit

 - 2021 audit program scope being developed in late 2020/early 2021.
