While preparing to remove the bushings on the rig floor to break out BHA, the crew member's hand was contacted by the bushing pulley connected to the winch cable that was being lifted using the doghouse controls. The winch cable was caught up on a protruding bolt and there was a sudden unexplained release when it came free

WHAT HAPPENED?

PRELIMINARY POST INCIDENT DISCOVERIES

- Winch cable connection link was snagged on a protruding bolt on the top drive
- IP was handling the bushing pulley connected to the swivel hook on the winch cable
- The sudden release of the snagged connection link resulted in the bushing pulley being raised to height

IMMEDIATE ACTIONS

- Ensure that you're positioned away from the Line of Fire
- Ensure hazard hunt is conducted on the rig floor and mast for protruding threads and bolts

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WHAT HAPPENED?

Operator's finger pinched between timber and BOP during maintenance operation

WHY?

- Supervisor failed to communicate on IP's hand position during the task
- Failed to assess task risk before proceeding



Adherence to this **Life-Saving Rule**

could have prevented this incident
I position myself to avoid moving objects, vehicles, pressure releases and dropped objects



REMEMBER

- Always apply "Hands Up Before Hands On"
- Employees to ensure hands free tools are used where applicable
- Communication is key to successful teamwork

WHAT WILL I DO?

- Is there a hands-free option available to hold equipment in place?
- Have I reviewed the HARC / Step 7 and completed all necessary checks?
